Safety recall on Land Rover Defender vehicles in the UAE announced



In coordination with the Ministry of Economy – Department of Consumer Protection and in line with the commitment of the Ministry of Economy to conduct an ongoing review of all products in the UAE to provide the consumer with the required protection, Al Tayer Motors, the local importer – dealer of Land Rover, and its subsidiary in Abu Dhabi and Al Ain, Premier Motors, announce a safety recall involving Land Rover Defender vehicles for a condition that can lead to a reduction in performance of the parking brake (hand brake) due to its friction material getting contaminated by transfer box oil leak. The recall includes Land Rover Defender 2007 to 2011 vehicles within the VIN range SALLDWAS87A730411 to SALLDWNS7BA823248.

A total of 301 vehicles are estimated to be affected in the UAE (manufactured in the United Kingdom). Owners of cars in the above-mentioned VIN range

are advised to take vehicles to the nearest Al Tayer Motors or Premier Motors' service centre to ensure repairs are carried out.

Land Rover has decided to implement this voluntary safety campaign to ensure the oil leak and contamination is contained. The modifications will be made free of charge and every effort will be made to minimise any inconvenience caused during the short time required for the work to be carried out.
